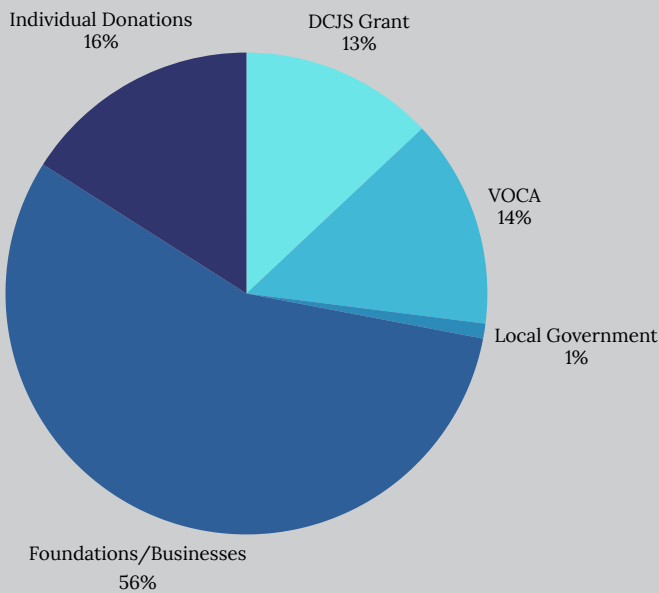

We were gifted a mural to enhance our office. It has been a wonderful addition. We also participated in the Warrenton Outer Town Limits Festival.

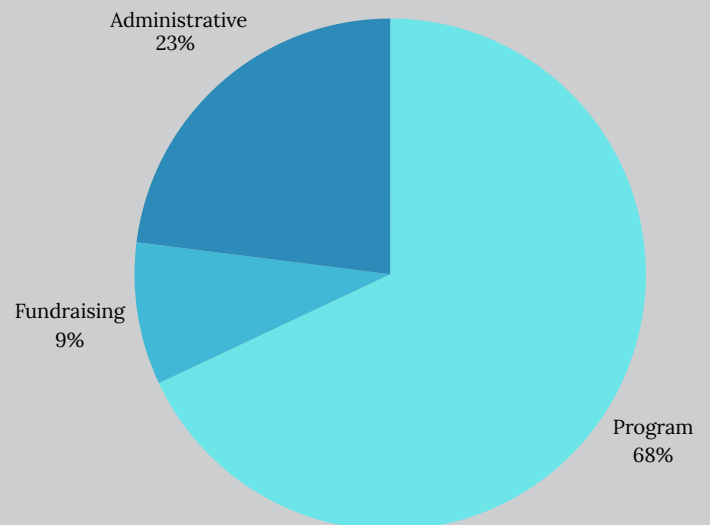
